## ORDER

## Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on the online first appeal bearing No. PODEP/A/E/22/00050 dated 13.05.2022, preferred by Manish Kumar r/o H. No. 554, New Police Line, Sector-26, Chandigarh under RTI Act 2005, received in this office through online RTI Request & Appeal Management Information System(RTI-MIS), against the disposal of his RTI application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/22/00285/3 dated 24.04.2022 by CPIO/Crime.

- The appellant, vide his RTI application dated 24.04.2022 under RTI Act 2005, had requested, Nodal Officer/PHQ to supply him some information in 18 points, about the current status of case FIR No. 43/2020 PS-26. Nodal Office/PHQ, further transferred the online RTI application vide No. No. PODEP/R/E/22/00285 to CPIO/District Crime Cell, No. PODEP/R/E/22/00285/1 to CPIO/Police Lines, No. PODEP/R/E/22/00285/2 to CPIO/Operation Cell, No. PODEP/R/E/22/00285/3 to CPIO/Crime Branch, No. PODEP/R/E/22/00285/4 to CPIO/Sub Division East and No. PODEP/R/E/22/00285/5 to CPIO/HQs for disposal at their own level. CPIO/Crime disposed-of the RTI application vide No. 13+13A/RTI/CPIO Crime dated 12.05.2022. The undersigned is the First Appellate Authority w.r.t. CPIO/Crime only.
- The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which his online RTI application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/22/00285/3 was disposed off, has filed the instant appeal alleging that the CPIO has refused access to information requested. The appellant has been contacted on his mobile No. i.e. 9478001155 on 01.06.2022 to confirm that the instant appeal is against CPIO/Crime only or against all the CPIOs. Sh. Manish Kumar confirmed that the appeal is against CPIO/Crime only.
- 4) The comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Crime have been called for. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by the CPIOs. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:-
