ORDER

The appellant has preferred online 1st appeal bearing No. PODEP/A/E/23/00113 dated 30.09.2023 against the disposal of his online RTI application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/23/00768 dated 01.09.2023 by CPIO/South-West with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his online RTI application had sought information on 02 points for supplying the certified copies of complaint-cum-statement signed by both, the appellant & his wife.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/South-West :-

CPIO/South-West vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from quarter concerned and the same i.e. copy of speed post receipt vide which the information was supplied to the appellant and copy of DDR No. 42 dated 08.05.2022 lodged on the complaint-cum-statement of both, the appellant and his wife, were again supplied to the appellant vide letter No. 222-RTI/CPIO/South-West dated 29.09.2023.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South-West vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application has sought information on 02 points for supplying the certified copies of complaint-cum-statement signed by both, the appellant & his wife.

Thereafter, CPIO/South-West had supplied the copy of speed post receipt vide which the information was earlier supplied to the appellant and copy of DDR No. 42 dated 08.05.2022 lodged on the complaint-cum-statement of both (the appellant and his wife), to the appellant.

So far as the appeal is concerned, the available information has already been provided to the appellant and no more action is warranted in the matter. Hence, the instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
