

**Deputy Inspector General of Police, UT, Chandigarh – cum- Appellate
Authority, Under Right to Information Act – 2005**

ORDER

This is an order on the appeal preferred by Sh. Shree Ram, resident of H.No. 1286, Indira Colony, Sec-17, Panchkula, Haryana, under RTI Act 2005. The RTI application was received in the office of the CPIO-Women Police Station, Home Guard Buildings Sec-17, UT, Chandigarh through registered post on 05.10.2020.


(2) The appellant, vide his application dated 05.10.2020 under RTI Act 2005 had requested CPIO, Police W&CSU seeking information about his certain queries/questions.

(3) The application was disposed of by CPIO (W&CSU) vide No. D-398/DSP/W&CSU, Chandigarh dated 21.10.2020, and was sent by registered post, well within the prescribed limitation period.

(4) Further, on 02.11.2020, another application of the appellant addressed to DSP-cum-CPIO/W&CSU was received mentioning that incomplete/incorrect information furnished by SHO/WPS Sec-17, Chandigarh under RTI Act – 2005.

(5) However, the appellant has sought new information in his appeal, for which the appellant is advised to apply fresh RTI application for seeking information, under RTI Act, 2005.

(6) The appeal is, therefore, disposed of with the advice to the appellant that if appellant is still not satisfied with the disposal of his RTI application, he can take up the matter with Hon'ble Central Information Commissioner, New Delhi.
