**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred 1<sup>st</sup> appeal (bearing No. PODEP/A/E/21/00029 dated 26.03.2021) against the reply/order of CPIO/Central in connection with his RTI application (bearing No. PODEP/R/E/21/000126 dated 17.02.2020) with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 23/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 26.03.2021 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

**INFORMATION SOUGHT IN RTI APPLICATION:-**

Appellant had sought information on 06 points in questioning form pertaining to complaint No. 2020-09146 filed by him.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/CENTRAL : -**

CPIO/Central submitted that application of the appellant was received online for supplying requisite information. After obtaining the requisite information from SHO/PS-11, appellant was informed that complaint in

question was under enquiry at that time. As of now, said complaint is still under process.

**DECISION:-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application & appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Central vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that appellant had information on 06 points in questioning form pertaining to complaint No. 2020-09146 filed by him.

Insofar as appeal is concerned, on carefully going through the contents of RTI application, it revealed that appellant has raised his queries regarding his complaint bearing No. 2020-09146 which is not covered under the definition of 'Information' depicted in section 2(f) of RTI Act as CPIO is only bound to furnish such information which is held by him.

Moreover, CPIO/Central has apprised about the status of complaint in question 2020-09146 was/(is) under enquiry. Hence, no more action is required to be taken in the instant appeal and the same is hereby disposed of.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
