THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER PHQs.-CUM-FIRST APPELLATE AUTHORITY-ESTABLISHMENT, UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

- 1. This is an order on the First Appeal Bearing no. PODEP/A/E/21/000013 on 19.02.2021 preferred by Sh.Jaswant Singh, o/o SDPO/East, Sector-26, Chandigarh under RTI Act 2005, against disposal of his online RTI application bearing no PODEP/R/E/21/00026 dated 14.01.2021 by CPIO/Estb.
- The appellant, vide his online RTI application under RTI Act 2005, had requested CPIO/Establishment to supply him some information pertaining to punishment registers being maintained in Chandigarh Police. The CPIO disposed of the same on 12.02.2021.
- 3. The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which his application was disposed of by the CPIO filed the instant appeal alleging the CPIO had refused access to information request.
- 4. The comments of Supdt-cum-CPIO/Estt have been called for she has reported that she has supplied the sought information.
- I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-à-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO/Estt.
