THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER PHQs.-CUM-APPELLATE AUTHORITY-ESTABLISHMENT, UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on the First Appeal Bearing No. PODEP/A/E/20/00090 dated 19.11.2020 preferred by Sh. Vikash Kalera, R/O VPO Garhi Chhani, Ward No. 05, Tehsil Bhadra, Dist. Hanumangarh, Rajasthan, under RTI Act 2005, against disposal of his online RTI application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/20/00446 dated 19.09.2020 by CPIO/Estb.

- 1. The appellant, vide his online RTI application under RTI Act 2005, had requested CPIO/Establishment to supply him some information pertaining to recruitment of Constable, Head Constable & Sub Inspector in Chandigarh Police. The CPIO disposed of the same on 16.10.2020.
- 2. The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which his application was disposed of by the CPIO filed the instant appeal alleging the CPIO had supplied him incomplete and misleading information.
- 3. The comments of Supdt-cum-CPIO/Estt have been called for she has reported that she has supplied the sought information.
- I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-à-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO/Estb. The appellant through RTI application, had sought information relating to number of police personnel employed in Chandigarh Police during current time, vacancies that may create in Chandigarh Police in future and reason for not filling these posts. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:-
