Applications (on-line on the Chandigarh Police website www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in) are invited from candidates to fill-up below mentioned 600 temporary posts of Constables(Male/Female) for Executive in Union Territory Chandigarh in the pay scale of Rs.3120-5160 (with the initial start of Rs. 3330) with usual allowances as admissible from time to time, under the rules:-

ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:-

(A) Age 18 to 23 years (as on 1.1.2009).

Relaxation:-

- i) Relaxable up to the age of 28 years for SC Candidates;
- ii) Relaxable up to the age of 26 years for OBC Candidates;
- iii) Relaxable up to the maximum age of 45 years for ex-servicemen provided break in service does not exceed two years from the date of discharge from army as on 1.1.2009. A candidate will be considered as Ex-Serviceman only if he is already discharged from army as on 1.1.2009;
- iv) Relaxation upto Five years (in addition to SC/OBC relaxation) for Home Guard Volunteers provided they are working/ on roll continuously for the last 2 years or more, as on 01.01.2009 as under: -
 - (I) 2 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 2 years or more as on 01.01.2009;

(II) 3 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 3 years or more as on 01.01.2009;

(III) 4 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 4 years or more as on 01.01.2009;

(IV) 5 years relaxations in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 5 years or more as on 01.01.2009.

To avail relaxation in age, as above, the candidate has to submit a certificate from District Commandant, Home Guards, in prescribed form whenever asked for during or after the recruitment process.

(v) Two years relaxation (in addition to SC/OBC relaxation) for wards (sons and daughters only) of working or retired or deceased Chandigarh Police employees.

(vi) Three years relaxation (in addition to SC/OBC relaxation) for wards (sons and daughters only) of Chandigarh Police employees, died while in service.

(B) Minimum Educational : 10+2 (as on
Qualification 1.1.2009)

(C) Height : 5' 7" (MALE)
5' 2" (female)

(D) Chest (Only for male) 33" (with expansion of
one and half inch)

- (2" relaxation (either in Height or in Chest) to the wards (sons and daughters only) of working/retired/deceased (except dismissed, compulsory retired or removed from service) Chandigarh Police employees) will be available. Not

more than two wards (sons and daughters) will be entitled to claim relaxation in height or chest.

For claiming relaxations, as above, please consult Standing Order No.36/2007 available on the Chandigarh Police website www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in.

The crucial/cut off date for all purposes such as minimum educational qualification, determining the age of the candidates, etc. will be treated as 1st January 2009. The candidates will submit their application on line on the website of Chandigarh Police on or before 20.08.2009 and will send downloaded hard copy after affixing latest passport size photograph alongwith copies of testimonials and bank draft for Rs.100/- (in favour of Section Officer/Accounts, UT Police Hqrs. Payable at Chandigarh) by registered post to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Lines, Police Lines, Sector-26, Chandigarh on or before 31.08.2009. Only "On-line" applications would be accepted.

Last date for sending hard copy (downloaded) affixed with latest passport size photograph alongwith bank draft of Rs.100/- and copies of testimonials is 31.08.2009.

Last date for applying for the post of constable is 20.08.2009 and only on-line applications would be accepted. Candidates can apply on line till 12 midnight on 20.08.2009 and the last date 31.08.2009 is only for the purpose of sending downloaded hard copy of application form through registered post or deposit in Police Lines, Sector-26, Chandigarh.

Candidates are advised to go through the guidelines/instructions for filling in the application forms (On-line) as well as standing order governing the recruitment of constables in Chandigarh police containing detailed criteria/eligibility conditions etc., which is available on the Chandigarh police website www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in. The candidates can also download/print copies of the guidelines/instructions as well as Standing Order No. 36/2007 from the above Chandigarh Police website.

Physical Efficiency Test (PET) & Physical Measurement Test (PMT) will start w.e.f. 21.09.2009 to 03.10.2009 in Police Lines, Sector-26, Chandigarh. Schedule for date and time will be available on Chandigarh Police website www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in w.e.f. 16.09.2009. No separate intimation regarding PET/PMT will be sent to individual candidate. Written test will be held on 11.10.2009 and result will be declared on 11.10.2009. The driving skill test will be conducted on 12.10.2009 and 13.10.2009 in new Police Lines Sector-26 Chandigarh. The candidates who will pass the PET/PMT, written test and driving test will be called for Interview w.e.f. 14.10.2009 to 17.10.2009. Final result will be declared on 19.10.2009
