ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:-

(A) Age 18 to 23 years (as on 01.01.2011)

Relaxation:-

- I) Relaxable up to the age of 28 years for SC candidates;
- II) Relaxable up to the age of 26 years for OBC candidates;
(Those categories/castes as per the Chandigarh Administration rules/guidelines)
- III) Relaxable up to the maximum age of 45 years for Ex-servicemen as on the cut-of date prescribed for the recruitment as on 01.01.2011.
- IV) Relaxation upto Five years (in addition to SC/OBC relaxation) for Home Guard Volunteers provided they are working/on roll continuously for the last 2 years or more, as on 01.01.2011 as under:-
 - (i) 2 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 2 years or more as on 01.01.2011.
 - (ii) 3 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 3 years or more as on 01.01.2011
 - (iii) 4 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 4 years or more as on 01.01.2011
 - (iv) 5 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 5 years or more as on 01.01.2011

(Note: To avail relaxation in age, as above, the candidate has to submit a certificate from District Commandant, Home Guards, in prescribed form as and when asked for during or after the recruitment process.)

- V) Two years relaxation (in addition to SC/OBC relaxation) for wards (sons only) of working or retired or deceased (except dismissed, compulsory retired or removed from service) Chandigarh Police employees.
- VI) Three years relaxation (in addition to SC/OBC relaxation) for wards (sons only) of Chandigarh Police employees, died while in service.

(B) Minimum Educational Qualification 10+2

RELAXATION IN EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:-

- I) For a person who have retired from the defence services and have worked as a member of the Defence Band Staff, the minimum educational qualification will be Middle standard ;
- II) For a person who have performed in Police Band or in Central Para Military Forces the minimum educational qualification will be Middle standard

(C)	Height	5' 7"
(D)	Chest (only for male)	33" (with expansion of one and half inch)

- 2" relaxation in Height and Chest to the wards (sons only) of working/retired/deceased (except dismissed, compulsory retired or removed from service) employees of Chandigarh Police.
- 2" relaxation in height to the resident of hill area will be available on production of Hill Area Certificate at the time of Physical Measurement Test {PMT} issued by the Competent Authority i.e. DC/DM/SDM or Tehsildar of their place of residence.
- 2" relaxation in Height and Chest to candidates who retired from the Defence services and have worked as a member of the Defence Band Staff.
- 2" relaxation (either in Height or in Chest) to candidates who have performed in Police Band or in Central Para Military Forces.
- For claiming relaxations, as above, please consult Standing Order available on the Chandigarh Police website www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in .
- The crucial/cut-of date for all purposes such as minimum educational qualification, determining the age of the candidates, etc. will be treated as 1st January 2011.
- The candidates will submit their application forms manually on the prescribed application form/proforma as per specimen available on the Chandigarh Police Website www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in **on or before 10.10.2011** addressed to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Lines, Sector-26, Chandigarh after affixing latest passport size photograph alongwith copies of testimonials and bank draft for Rs.100/- (in favour of "Section Officer/Accounts, Sector-9, UT/Police Headquarters" Payable at Chandigarh) by registered/speed post.
- Last date for submitting application forms affixed with latest passport size photograph alongwith copies of testimonials and bank draft of Rs.100/- on or before **10.10.2011**.

Candidates are advised to go through the guidelines/instructions for filling in the application forms manually as well as Standing Order governing the recruitment of constables (Band Staff) in Chandigarh police containing detailed criteria/eligibility conditions etc., which is available on the Chandigarh Police website www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in. The candidates can also download/print copies of the guidelines/instructions as well as Standing Order from the above Chandigarh Police website.

Candidates can apply on or before **10.10.2011** by sending application form through registered post or deposit in-person in Police Lines, Sector-26, Chandigarh
