Applications (on-line on the Chandigarh Police website [www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in](http://www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in)) are invited from candidates to fill-up below mentioned 1200 temporary posts of Constables (Executive) in Chandigarh Police in the pay scale of Rs.5910-20200 + Grade Pay of Rs.1900 with usual allowances as admissible from time to time, under the rules:-

**ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS:-**

- (A) Age 18 to 23 years (as on 01.01.2010).  
Relaxation:-
- I) Relaxable up to the age of 28 years for SC Candidates;
  - II) Relaxable up to the age of 26 years for OBC Candidates;
  - III) Relaxation upto Five years (in addition to SC/OBC relaxation) for Home Guard Volunteers provided they are working/ on roll continuously for the last 2 years or more, as on 01.01.2010 as under: -
    - (i) 2 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 2 years or more as on 01.01.2010;
    - (ii) 3 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 3 years or more as on 01.01.2010;
    - iii) 4 years relaxation in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 4 years or more as on 01.01.2010;
    - iv) 5 years relaxations in age to those Home Guard Volunteers who are working/on roll continuously for 5 years or more as on 01.01.2010.(Note: To avail relaxation in age, as above, the candidate has to submit a certificate from District Commandant, Home Guards, in prescribed form as and when asked for during or after the recruitment process.)
  - (IV) Two years relaxation (in addition to SC/OBC relaxation) for wards (sons and daughters only) of working or retired or deceased (except dismissed, compulsory retired or removed from service) Chandigarh Police employees.

- (V) Three years relaxation (in addition to SC/OBC relaxation) for wards (sons and daughters only) of Chandigarh Police employees, died while in service.
- (B) Minimum Educational : 10+2 (as on 01.01.2010)  
Qualification
- (C) Height: : 5' 7" (Male)  
5' 2" (Female)
- (D) Chest (Only for male) : 33" (with expansion of one and half inch)
- 2" relaxation (either in Height or in Chest) to the wards (sons and daughters only) of working/retired/deceased (except dismissed, compulsory retired or removed from service) Chandigarh Police employees will be available. Not more than two wards (sons and daughters) will be entitled to claim relaxation in height or chest.
  - 2" relaxation in height to the resident of hill area will be available on production of certificate (at the time of Physical Measurement Test) to this effect (Hill Area Certificate) issued by the Competent Authority i.e. DC/DM/SDM or Tehsildar of their place of residence.
  - For claiming relaxations, as above, please consult Standing Order available on the Chandigarh Police website [www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in](http://www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in).
  - The crucial/cut off date for all purposes such as minimum educational qualification, determining the age of the candidates, etc. will be treated as Ist January 2010. The candidates will submit their application on-line on the website of Chandigarh Police on or before 30.04.2010 and will send downloaded hard copy after affixing latest passport size photograph alongwith copies of testimonials and bank draft for Rs.100/- (in favour of "Section Officer/Accounts, UT Police Hqrs." Payable at Chandigarh) by registered post to the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Lines, Police Lines, Sector-26, Chandigarh on or before 18.05.2010.

- Last date for sending hard copy(downloaded) affixed with latest passport size photograph alongwith bank draft of Rs.100/- and copies of testimonials is 18.05.2010.
- Only on-line applications would be accepted. Candidates can apply on line w.e.f. 15.03.2010 till 30.04.2010 and the last date 18.05.2010 is only for the purpose of sending downloaded hard copy of application form through registered post or deposit in Police Lines, Sector-26, Chandigarh.
- Candidates are advised to go through the guidelines/ instructions for filling in the application forms (On-line) as well as standing order governing the recruitment of constables in Chandigarh police containing detailed criteria/eligibility conditions etc., which is available on the Chandigarh police website [www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in](http://www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in). The candidates can also download/print copies of the guidelines/instructions as well as Standing Order from the above Chandigarh Police website.
- Physical Efficiency Test (PET) & Physical Measurement Test (PMT) will be held in the month of July, 2010 in Police Lines, Sector 26, Chandigarh followed by Written Test, Driving Test & Interview. The schedule for PET/PMT will be available on the official web site of Chandigarh Police [www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in](http://www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in) on 25.06.2010 onwards. The candidates are advised to check the schedule for PET/PMT on 25.06.2010 onwards on the website of Chandigarh Police. No separate intimation regarding PET/PMT will be sent to individual candidates.
- The Constable appointed can be deployed in any unit of Chandigarh Police like Traffic, CID, Wireless, IRB etc. and anywhere in India. On-Line submission of application forms on the website of Chandigarh Police [www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in](http://www.chandigarhpolice.nic.in) will start w.e.f. 15.03.2010.
